

COOKIE NOTICE

Effective Date: July 23, 2019



1. Introduction

1.1. This Cookie Notice (“Cookie Notice” or “Notice”) applies to Associated Energy Group, LLC (“AEG”, “we”, “us” or “our”). Like most businesses, we employ “cookies” or similar technologies. This Cookie Notice tells you about our use of cookies and similar technologies on our website, www.aegfuels.com, and any other websites linking to this Notice (collectively, our “website”). For further information about how we use, store, disclose and process personal information that we obtain through or in connection with the use of our website, please visit our [Privacy Policy](#).

1.2. When you first access our website from certain jurisdictions, you may receive a message advising you that cookies and similar technologies are in use. By clicking “**accept cookies**”, closing the message, or continuing to browse the website, you signify that you understand and agree to the use of these technologies, as described in this Cookie Notice.

1.3. You do not have to accept cookies and consent can be withdrawn at any time (See ‘How to Control Cookies’, below). You can change your browser settings to refuse or restrict cookies, and you may delete them after they have been placed on your device at any time. If you do not accept or delete our cookies, some areas of our website that you access may take more time to work, or may not function properly.

2. What are cookies?

2.1. Cookies are small files containing a string of characters which we may store on your computer or mobile device when you visit our website. When you visit our website, the cookies allow us to recognize your browser. Cookies may store your preferences and other information but cannot read data off your hard disk or read cookie files created by other sites.

2.2. Cookies set by a website owner (in this case, AEG) are called “**first party cookies**”. Cookies set by parties other than the website owner are called “**third party cookies**”. Third party cookies enable third party features or functionality to be provided on or through the website (e.g. analytics).

3. The cookies we use

3.1. Cookies make the use of our website easier by, among other things, saving your preferences. We may also use cookies to deliver content tailored to your interests. Our cookies may enable us to relate your use of our website to personal information that you previously submitted.

3.2. The information that we collect with cookies allows us to statistically analyze usage of our website, and to improve and customize our content and other offerings. However, we only disclose information collected with cookies to third parties on an aggregated basis without the use of any information that personally identifies you.

3.3. The specific types of first party and third party cookies placed by our website and the purposes they perform are described in the table below:

<p>Strictly Necessary Cookies</p> <p>These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website, use our customer services chat features, use a shopping cart or make use of e-billing services.</p>	<p>- AEG</p>	<p>These cookies are strictly necessary to deliver the website and therefore cannot be refused. They can be deleted or blocked using your browser settings, however (see Section 4, How to control cookies, below).</p>
<p>Performance and Functionality Cookies</p> <p>These are used to recognize you when you return to our website. This enables us to personalize our content for you and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region), but are non-essential to the performance of the website.</p>	<p>- AEG - Cloudflare</p>	<p>These cookies can be deleted or blocked using your browser settings (see Section 4, How to control cookies, below).</p>
<p>Analytical or Customization Cookies</p> <p>These cookies collect information about how users access and move through the website. 4. How to control cookies

5. Web beacons

5.1. As well as cookies, we use other technologies to recognize and track visitors to our website. A web beacon (also known as a “**tracking pixel**” or “**clear GIF**”) is a clear graphic image (typically a one-pixel tag) that is delivered through a web browser or HTML e-mail, typically in conjunction with a cookie.

5.2. Web beacons allows us, for example, to monitor how users move from one page within our website to another, to track access to our communications and to improve website performance.
